

UK NEQAS Pilot EQA Scheme for**Digital Electrophoretic Patterns****Registration Now Open**

A web based programme containing virtual cases for identifying serum protein electrophoretic (SPE) patterns and the associated clinical condition.

Digital Cases

- **Comprehensive digital case material** – including capillary zone electrophoresis, gel electrophoresis, immunofixation, immunosubtraction, and immunoglobulin result sets.
- **Flexible access options** – individual user participation available through multi-user laboratory subscriptions.
- **Confidential user reports** – each participant receives personalised feedback to support learning and development.
- **Training Manager Portal** – monitor competence and progression of staff with:
 - An overall consensus report for the laboratory.
 - Access to individual user performance data and trends over time.
- **Supports training & CPD** – enabling laboratories to use EQA participation as both a quality measure and a structured staff training tool.

Identification of SPE patterns associated with various clinical conditions

**Accreditation Status**

This scheme is in Pilot phase and is therefore not currently accredited.

**Distribution Information**

2 digital cases (no physical samples) distributed 4 times per year.
